

Fiddlermans Rhythm Chart

Learn your RHYTHMS

Whole note = 4 beats

Half note = 2 beats
A dot adds half the value = 3 beats

Half note = 2 beats

Quarter note = 1 beat

Eighth note = 1/2 a beat

1 2 3 4 1 2 3 4 1 2 3 4 1 2 3 4 1 & 2 & 3 & 4 &

Sixteenth note = 1/4 beat
= 4 notes per beat

Dotted quarter adds half the value and becomes 1 quarter plus an eighth = 3 eighth notes

Dotted eighth adds half the value and becomes 1/8th plus 1/16th = 3 16th notes

1 e & da 2 e & da 3 e & da 4 e & da 1 & 2 & 3 & 4 & 1e&da 2e&da 3e&da 4e&da 1 &da 2 &da 3 &da 4 &da

Hat = 2 beats rest
next rest = 1 beat
next 2 = 1/2 a beat

Upsidedown hat = 4 beats rest

1 e da 2 e da 3 e da 4 e da 1 e & 2 e & 3 e & 4 e & 1 2 3 4 1 2 3 4 &

This first rest is a 1/6th rest and = to 1/4 of a beat

3 eighth note triplets = one beat

1 e &da 2 & 3 4 1 & da 2 & da 3 & da 4 & da 1 & da 2 & da 3 & da 4 & da
