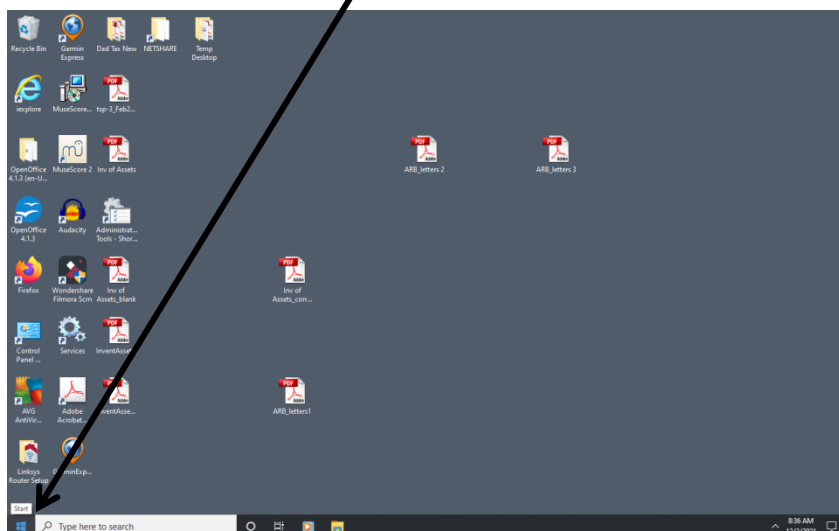


1. Plug Ipad into PC via USB cable (same as Ipad charging cable).
2. Ipad will ask **Allow this device to access photos and videos?**—on the Ipad, select **Allow**
3. On PC, a window may pop up to indicated Ipad is connected:

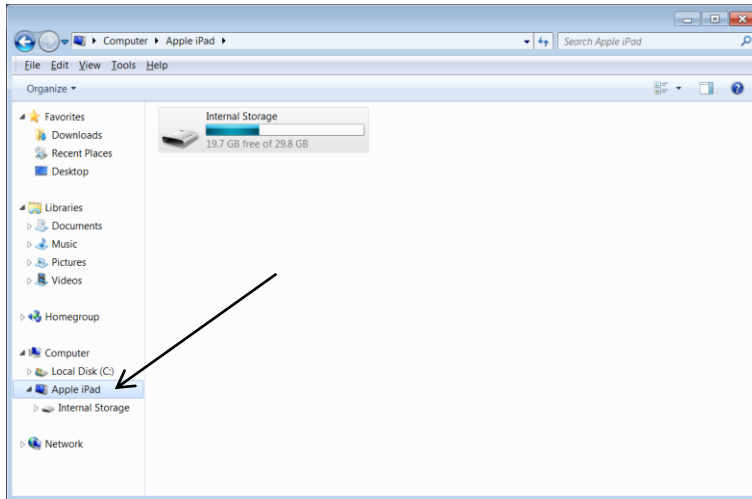


If this appears, click on **Open device to view files using Windows Explorer**. If no window appears, go directly to File Explorer (or Windows Explorer):

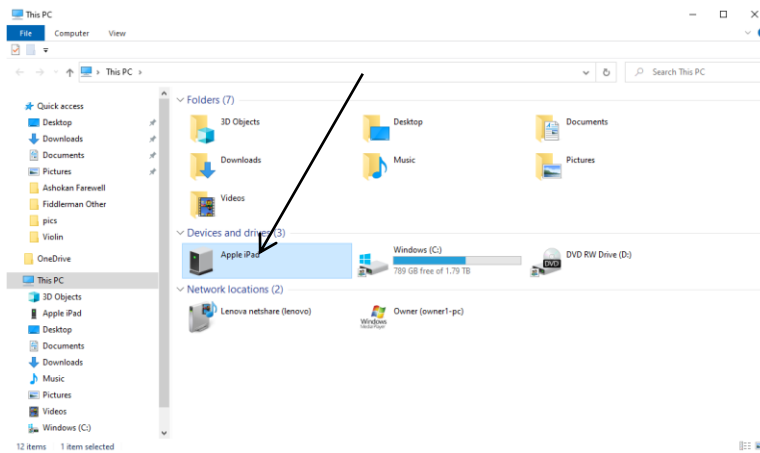
3A. Right mouse click on the Windows icon (a.k.a Start icon) on bottom left of your PC screen (will look different on different versions on Windows), and click **File Explorer** (or **Open Windows Explorer**).



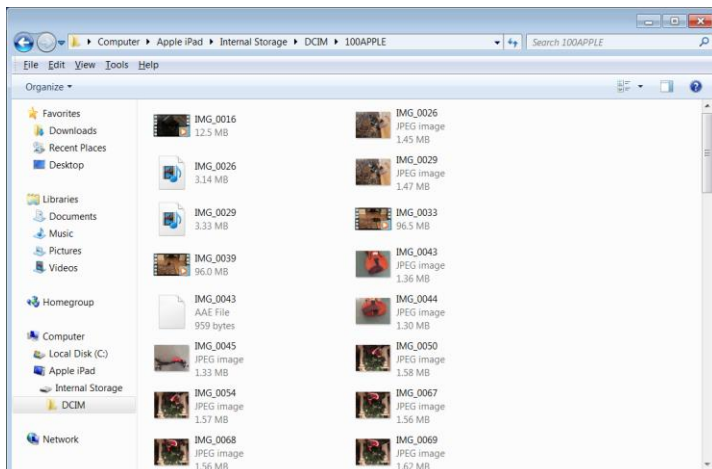
4. Find the Apple iPad device:



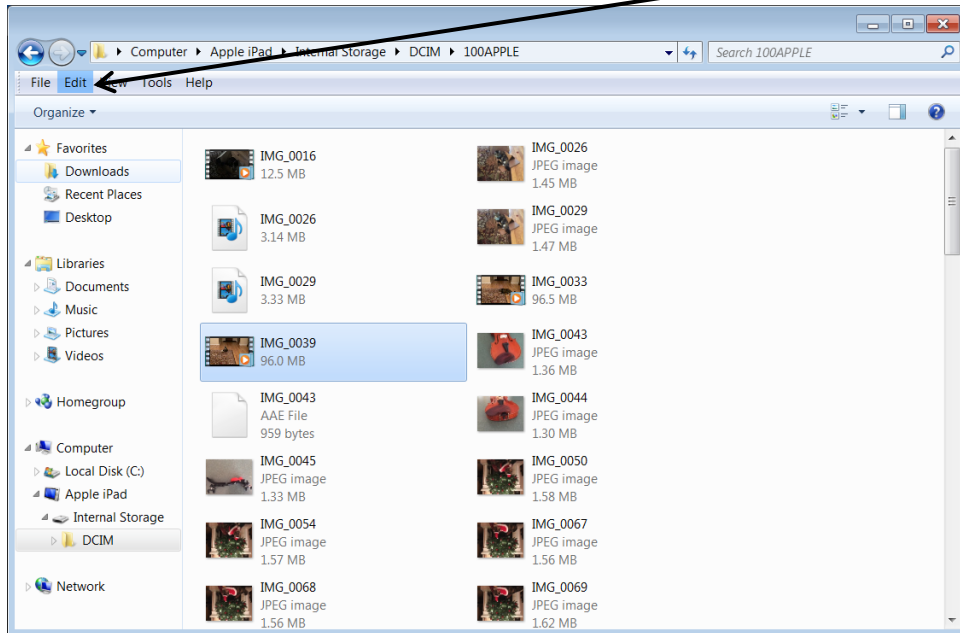

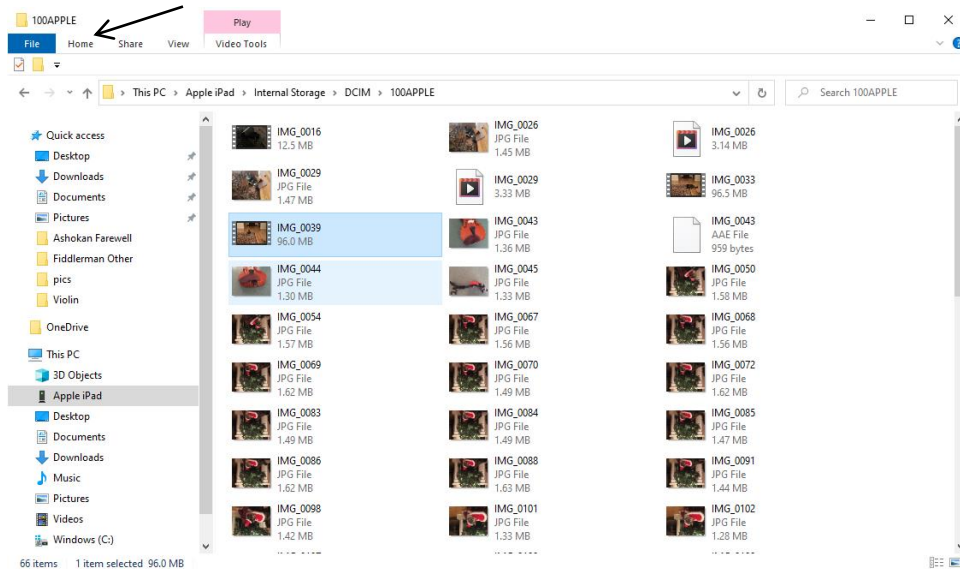
5. Double click on Internal Storage, then DCIM, and then 100Apple (may have a different name). You should see your picture/video files on your Ipad.



6. Click to highlight the file you want to copy to your PC. Then click on **Edit, & Copy**:



Or **Home**, and then **Copy**:



7. Once you copy, you can paste to your PC. You can right click your mouse on your desktop, & click **Paste**, and it will put file on your desktop.
